The new filter-based search engines have been reengineered to improve search speed, responsiveness, and overall user experience. The entire [NICU Directory](#) provides data on 1,386 Level II, III, and IV NICUs in the U.S., regardless of hiring status. The regularly updated [Job Directory](#) focuses on just those NICUs with active open positions, with filters to drill down to your ideal practice parameters, such as type of practice, number of hospitals covered, and geographic location.

Sites are encouraged to submit information about open Neonatologist positions via this [submission form](#). There is no cost to post or view these submissions, and NNP and NICU Hospitalist positions will be coming soon! At present, there are more than 180 NICUs with open positions.
